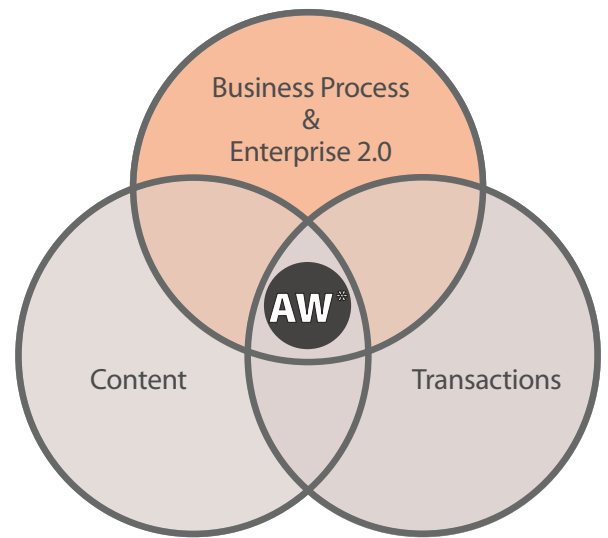

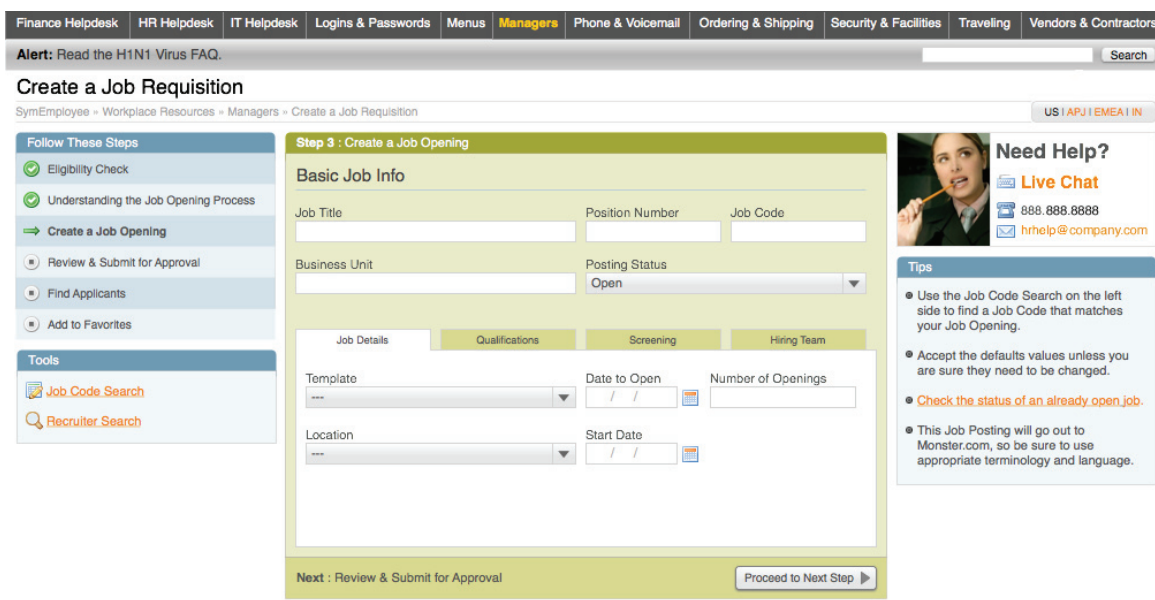

## Navigating your business processes

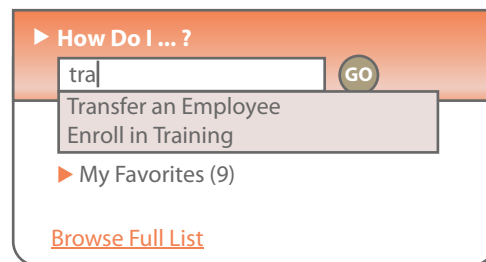
The Assembly Wizard is best used to map out a series of steps in a business process. Those steps may have a strict order that must be followed or a loose order that is suggested. Either way, Assembly Wizard automatically creates business process navigation to guide the user through a process one step at a time. The user knows what to expect and where they are in the process at all times.

### "How Do I"

"How Do I" is Assembly Wizard's search and it's located right on a user's homepage. How Do I presents an auto-suggest search box where the user can ask any question such as "How do I order office supplies?" or "How do I change my benefits?" How Do I immediately suggests popular questions that meet your search terms and takes the user directly to the appropriate business process. How Do I is also smart enough to know that a person's location or role can help determine which process is best suited for that user. For example, hiring someone in Hong Kong likely involves different steps and documentation to hiring someone in New York.

## Secure Enterprise Wiki

Security within Assembly Wizard is completely role-based allowing unique groups of authors, approvers, administrators, and viewers. Finely grained security such as this allows for decentralized creation within defined controls. Functional groups can now take control of their content and transactions allowing for better autonomy. Something even Wikipedia can't do!

Your users know what works best for them. Tapping into this tribal knowledge and opinions can be paramount in a successful implementation. Assembly Wizard allows any user the ability to rate a page or process from one to five stars.
